In the night between Sunday 16th of September and Monday 17th of September a new bear arrived from Šmrika, a village near Rijeka.

He was only 8 months young and 29 kilos light, the first couple of weeks he did not have a name. But now he has a name worth waiting for—it's Marko Kralj. Marko from the latin name meaning Mars, the god of war, and Kralj from the Croatian word meaning king.

Autumn in Croatia



Croatia is getting ready for winter. Here in Kuterevo we're harvesting. preserving and conserving vegetables (onions, garlic, cabbage, tomatoes, pumpkins, cucumber) and fruits (plums, cornels /cormus más), making ajvar, jam, syrup and rakija. Also the bears are preparing—they're getting fatter every day!

We received two trucks loaded with tons of bread and sweet corn for the bears; that will be enough to get them through the winter. We've also prepared a lot of fire wood for heating the volunteers station.

Another autumn sign is the tradicional

autumn markets, and we have atended few of them—"Eko-Etno Gacka" market in Otočac, "Vinkovačke jeseni" in Vinkovci, "Jesen u Lici" in Gospić and healthy food market in Vrhovine for the World Food Day.
